SSCo of the Year

A school sport co-ordinator who works/has worked in the Redditch Partnership and has shown dedication to providing wider PE and sports opportunities both within the curriculum and with innovative ideas. They do not have to work at your school, it could be through work they have done for the family of schools.

FSLT/PLT of the Year

A first/primary school link teacher who works/has worked in the Redditch partnership and has shown dedication and determination to raise the profile and quality of PE and School Sport in their school.

Most Improved Pupil Award

Any aged pupil, male or female who through PE and School Sport has shown significant improvement in any or all below:

- Attendance
- Behaviour
- Attitude
- Achievement

Sports Leader of the Year

A student who has helped people reach their potential, showing good teamwork, organisation and motivational skills.

Senior Team

A high school team who has displayed consistent standard of behaviour and has achieved and delivered to the best of their ability at all times.

Junior Team

A first or middle school team who has displayed consistent standard of behaviour and has achieved and delivered to the best of their ability at all times.

Performer of the Year

Male or Female performer, an aesthetic athlete who has shown dedication to their sport and has achieved significant recognition within their chosen sport/activity.

Outstanding Contribution to PE and School Sport

An individual that has made a significant contribution to enhancing PE and School Sport.

Junior Team of the Year

A team who have achieved, and attained a high level of performance. They have also displayed good attitude and aptitude in their chosen sport.

Club of the Year

A club who have achieved accreditation recognition and have enabled individuals to perform and compete at a level that is appropriate to those individuals needs.

Disabled Sports Personality of the Year

An individual who has shown commitment, and have achieved success in their own right either through taking part in sport or volunteering.

Outstanding Contribution Award

For those that have made a significant contribution to the development of sport in administration, organisation or other supportive roles.

Senior Sports Personality of the Year

An individual over 18yrs of age who has achieved a good standard of performance and has represented or contributed to a sport or club through their own dedication and commitment.

Coach of the Year

A person involved in coaching at any level; who has shown high levels of achievement when developing improved performance amongst sports people.

Junior Sports Personality of the Year

An individual under the age of 18yrs of age who either plays in a team or competes as an individual and has achieved significant recognition within their chosen sport or activity.

Volunteer of the Year

For those who have voluntarily given up their time to coaching / involvement in sport from an administrative, organisational or other supportive role.
